### **NEW GRADUATE STUDENT INFORMATION July 2021**

### **Conditions on Your Offer of Admission**

Ensure that the conditions on your offer of admission are met. Conditions will vary, with the most common involving transcripts. I have provided a couple of examples below. If Western (or affiliate) is the only campus you have attended, you are not required to provide an official transcript and you may skip this section.

Condition\*: You are required to have the Registrar of each institution you attended send directly to SGPS all official FINAL transcript(s), indicating degrees awarded (if applicable). \*If your degree was in progress at the time of application and you will graduate in the spring, wait until after convocation to have the transcript for your current degree sent to Western. After convocation, the transcript will indicate that the degree has been awarded and that will take care of two conditions at the same time. If you will be completing over the summer term and your convocation will be in the fall, you will need to send an official transcript to Western now and another one after your convocation (showing that the degree has been awarded).

Condition\*\*: You are required to have the Registrar of each institution you attended send directly to SGPS all official transcript(s). \*\*Western requires an official transcript from each postsecondary institution you have attended.

## **Scholarship Funding**

Your scholarship funding will be applied directly to your tuition and fees each term and serves as your 'first installment.' The amount will appear as 'pending financial aid' in your student account until it is applied to your tuition on the first day of each term. You may pay the remainder by the 'second installment' deadline (early in the second month of the term) without penalty. If paying through your bank online, be sure to allow 2-3 business days for payment to be processed to your tuition account.

## **Health Insurance**

Students from outside Canada are required to join the University Health Insurance Plan when they arrive. International students should make arrangements in their home country for health insurance coverage while travelling to Canada. Canadian students from outside Ontario covered by a provincial plan should contact their plan to advise them of enrolment at Western. Extended health insurance benefits are offered automatically for full-time graduate students through the Society of Graduate Students (SOGS), provided the student is covered by his/her provincial health plan or has an OHIP equivalent plan (e.g., UHIP). The annual fee (September 2018 through August 2019) for the health plan is included in student activity fees in the Fall term.
